Jar Pincushion

Supplies:

Canning Jar or other plastic/glass container – Dollar Tree has a supply of sizes and shapes.

Fabric aprx. 2" larger than lid

Glue: Hot Glue or Super Glue

Optional: Ribbon and Button

Filing – Examples: Batting, Steel Wool, Polyfil, Crushed Walnuts, Aquarium Sand

1. Remove the jar lid. Draw a circle 1" to 2" larger than ring of the lid. Cut.



2. If using a jar without the ring, Trace the lid on cardboard. Cut.



3. Hand sew a running (long) stitch aprx 1/4" around the perimeter.



4. Gently pull the thread tight creating a gathered edge. Leave an opening.



5. Add filling such as batting. Insert disk from the lid. Pull thread as desired. Knot.



6. Option: If you prefer a larger top or have difficulty closing the lid, use a second ring and glue together.



7. Or you can insert into jar ring pulling thru the top so bulk is not under the edge of the ring.



8. Optional: Glue ribbon edge of lid.



9. Optional: Glue button to conceal the ends. Then attach the lid to the jar.
